

THIS IS A PRAYER CALENDAR.

We've already established that most folks just aren't that excited about the talking-in-church-about-money thing. But we're also beginning to discover that financial giving is an important part of your spiritual growth plan. So there's a bit of a conflict there, right? Wanna know a great tool for working out conflicts—especially heart-mind conflict? Prayer. (You knew that already, didn't you?) Sometimes it's difficult to figure out exactly how to pray about things like money, though, so we wanted to give you a tool to help you out.

EVERYDAY READ THE VERSES. PRAY THE PRAYER. OBTAIN CLARITY.

(IT TOTALLY WORKS.)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7

- SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24** Read Exodus 35:21-29
Ask God to prepare your heart for what He wants to show you over the next 30 days.
- SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25** Read Deuteronomy 8:18
Thank God for all He's done for you, and then ask Him to show you opportunities to care for others—not for your glory, but for His.
- MONDAY, OCTOBER 26** Read John 14:16-17
Pray that you will grow in your love for God and that your words and actions will show God to those around you.
- TUESDAY, OCTOBER 27** Read 1 Peter 2:9-10
Ask God about what you can do now that will have a future impact in our community.

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 1 Read Isaiah 56:7
Ask to understand the importance Jesus placed on prayer.

COLE, AGE 6.

→ KEEP PRAYING.

- MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2** Read Psalm 127:1
Pray that the Holy Spirit directs our financial giving and that we hear and follow His leading.
- TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3** Read 1 Corinthians 3:9-17
Thank God that Jesus Christ is your sure foundation.
- WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4** Read Matthew 21:21-22
Ask for increased faith to believe. Do not doubt.
- THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5** Read Colossians 3:12-17
Pray that you may know and express the love and compassion of Christ and that the peace of Christ would reign in your heart.
- FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 6** Read Ephesians 4:11-16
Pray that you will be more and more like Christ every day and that each person at Morning Star Church will know and embrace his or her role in the body.
- SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 7** Read Ephesians 1:15-23
Ask for the Spirit of wisdom and revelation so you may know God better.
- SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8** Read Luke 11:1-13)
Thank Jesus for teaching you to pray.
- MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9** Read Romans 8:25-28
Know that the Spirit helps you pray even when you aren't sure what or how to pray.
- TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 10** Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18
Pray to develop an attitude of gratitude and for intimacy in your prayer life.
- WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 11** Read 1 John 5:14-15
Pray to know His will for you.
- THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12** Read John 3:16
Thank God for His ultimate sacrificial gift.

KEEP PRAYING. ←

- FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13** Read Mark 12:41-44
Pray that God will show you the meaning of sacrificial giving.
- SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 14** Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7
Ask God to reveal the motives of your heart.
- SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15** Read Acts 20: 35
Ask to learn the true joy of giving from the heart.
- MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16** Read 2 Corinthians 9:9-15
Pray that as God supplies your needs, you may help supply the needs of others.
- TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17** Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-7
Pray that God reminds you daily to seek Him first and that He strengthens your faith so you can surrender fully to Him.
- WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18** Read Luke 6:38
Pray that your giving will no longer feel like an obligation, but instead that it will feel like an investment in God's people.
- THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 19** Read Matthew 6:19-21
Ask God to protect you from our culture's tendency to be consumed by consumption. Pray that you'll become more focused on heavenly treasures than on earthy pleasures.
- FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20** Read Philippians 1:3-11
Thank God for His promise that He will complete what He has begun in you.
- SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 21** Read Ephesians 3:14-21
Pray that you begin to have an understanding of the depth and breadth of God's love for you. Trust that He wants to do exceedingly and abundantly more in your life than you could ever ask or imagine.
- SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 22** Read Psalm 118:21-24
Rejoice and be glad for this is the day the Lord has made! Thank Him for your salvation, and praise Him that Christ is at the center of our church.

Dear God,

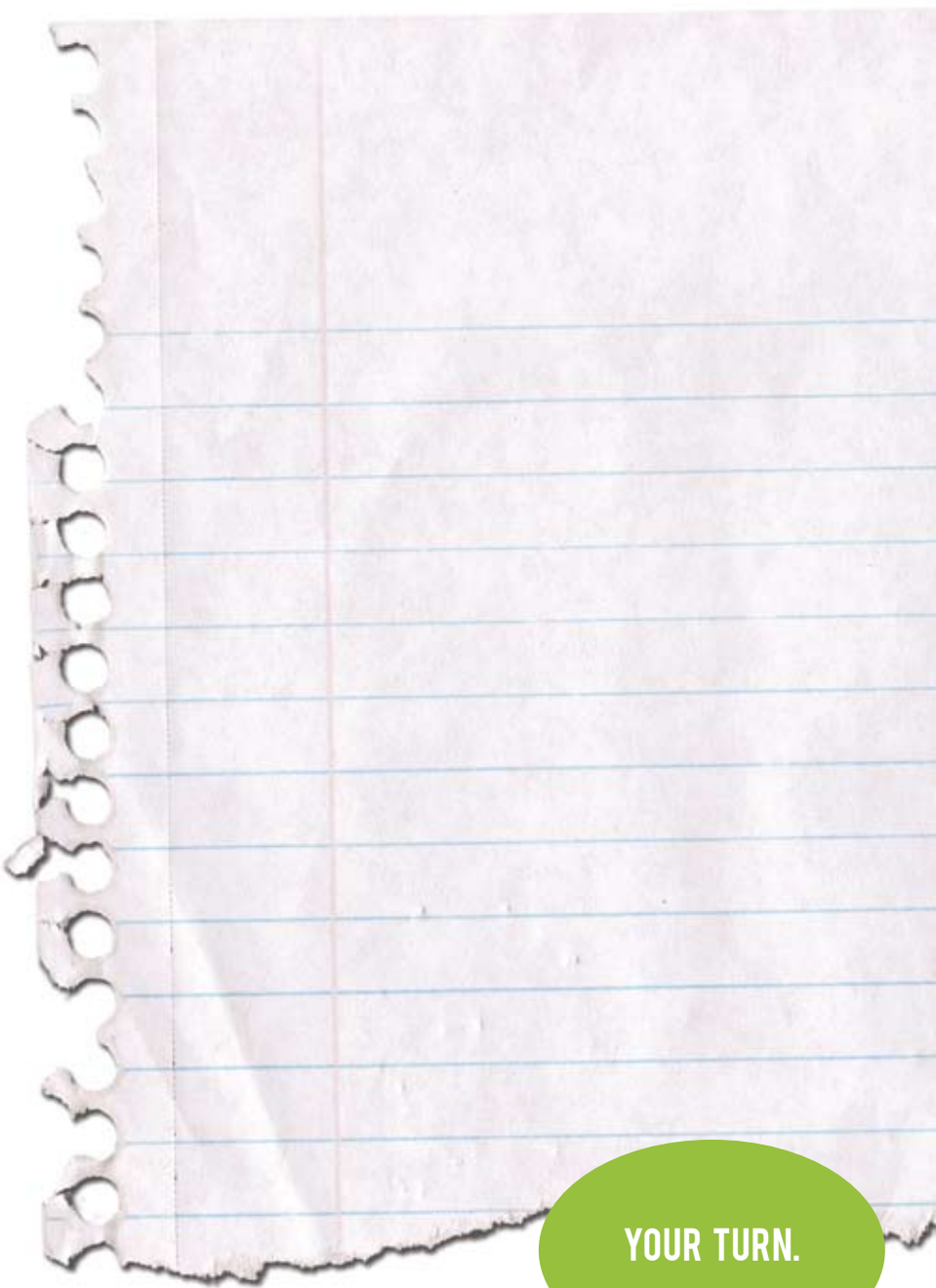
